

Floyd County Board of Canvassers Meeting
November 13, 2023, 1:00 p.m.

The Floyd County Board of Supervisors/Canvassers met for the Tier 1 Canvass of the November 7, 2023 City-School Election at Floyd County Courthouse Assembly Room with the following in attendance: Supv Mark Kuhn, Supv Dennis Keifer, and Supv Jim Jorgensen.

Supv Kuhn announced the canvass and Auditor Carr presented the tally books for review.

Keifer/Jorgensen moved to approve Res #43-23* Certification of Floyd County Election Results, November 7, 2023 City-School Election – Tier 1 Canvass: The City/School Election was held on November 7, 2023, and the Board of Supervisors/ex-officio Board of Canvassers have canvassed the vote of said elections in accordance with Iowa Code Section 50.24, now therefore, be it resolved that the Board hereby certifies the voter turnout, the Tier-1 Canvass and results for the City/School Election held November 7, 2023 and that no obvious clerical errors were identified during the canvass. Turnout: 3,210 people voted; 2,683 people voted at the polls on election day, 527 absentee ballots were accepted for counting, 1 absentee ballot was returned by mail after the election, making it ineligible to count and another mailed absentee ballot was never received back. There were no provisional ballots to count. Candidates elected by the voters of the respective cities: City of Charles City Council At-Large - Phillip Knighten-841, Phoebe Pittman-838 & Keith Starr-814; City of Colwell - Mayor - Jeffrey Wright*-8 and Council - Kim Isakson-8, Ryan Wegner-7, Rachel Krause-5, Kim Blunt-5 & Mark Kirsch-5; City of Floyd Mayor - Trevis O'Connell-51 and Council - Cleone King-52, Jeremy Stewart-50 & Doug Davis-45; City of Marble Rock - Mayor Jerry Engelhardt-33, Council - Kaylah Schweizer-56 & Jerry Hubbard-22, and Council To Fill A Vacancy - Bradley A. Rohwedder-58 & Lynn Kingery-36; City of Nora Springs Mayor - Randy Hassman-236 and Council - Sarah Avery-166, Duane Koch-156, & Dain Mann-110; City of Rockford - Mayor Scott Johnson-140 and Council - Alexandra Seibert-136 & Derek Johnson-135; City of Rudd Mayor - Jeff Buland-16 and Council - Amy Leaman-8, Tyler Scheer-7 & Craig Reinke-6

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Floyd County Auditor/Commissioner of Elections shall maintain the Official Canvass and Abstracts for the Tier 1 Canvass of the CITY-SCHOOL ELECTION.

The meeting concluded with the Floyd County Board of Canvassers signing the Official Canvass and Abstract of Votes to be attested by the Clerk to the Board of Supervisors. Control County abstracts and canvass materials include the Cities of Charles City, Colwell, Floyd, Marble Rock, Nora Springs, Rockford and Rudd. Non-control county abstracts and canvass materials include: Butler County (North Butler Community School District), Cerro Gordo County (North Iowa Community College), Chickasaw County (City of Nashua and Nashua-Plainfield Community School District), Mitchell County (Osage Community School District) and Worth County (Central Springs Community School District).

Jorgensen/Keifer moved to adjourn. Motion carried 3-0.
