June 2, 2025, 9:00 a.m.

The Floyd County Board of Supervisors met in the Floyd County Courthouse Board Room. Supervisors Boyd Campbell and Gloria Carr were in attendance. Dennis Keifer was absent.

Carr/Campbell moved to approve the agenda. Motion carried 2-0.

Public comment: Mark Kuhn asked about the Wind Energy and Battery Storage Work Group report scheduled for Tuesday, June 17—specifically the time, location, and presenters. Campbell said the full working group will present their findings to the Board. Kuhn also asked if a report will be made public and when; Campbell stated that is currently unknown.

Updates on various boards/commissions/activities: Carr attended Area Development Corporation meeting, County Social Services Meeting, and participated in a SW Bypass dissolution discussion.

Carr/Campbell moved to approve Ahlers & Cooney invoices: \$2,988.37 for judicial review of IUC permit and \$351.00 for pipeline and row ordinances. Motion carried 2-0.

Tim Fox, ADC Director, emphasized the importance of the County's continued support for the Area Development Corporation (ADC). Carr/Campbell moved to approve authorizing Campbell to sign a letter of support for ADC's reaccreditation application to the International Economic Development Council. Motion carried 2-0.

Carr/Campbell moved to approve the appropriation of \$50,000 from the General Basic Fund to the Emergency Management Fund. Motion carried 2-0.

Carr/Campbell moved to approve Res #24-25* Interfund Transfer from General Services to Secondary Roads: The Board approved the transfer of \$131,101 from the General Basic Fund to the Secondary Road Fund for taxes collected and directed the Auditor to update records and notify the County Treasurer accordingly. Roll call vote: Ayes-Carr, Campbell; motion carried 2-0.

Carr/Campbell moved to approve Res #25-25 *Interfund Transfer from Rural Services to Secondary Roads: The Board approved the transfer of \$1,516,798 from the Rural Services Basic Fund to the Secondary Road Fund for taxes collected and directed the Auditor to update records and notify the County Treasurer accordingly. Roll call vote: Ayes-Carr, Campbell; motion carried 2-0.

Future agenda items: presentations on the Wind Energy and Battery Storage Work Group, the FY24 External Audit Report, a Public Purpose Resolution, insurance proposals, and the codification of ordinances.

Carr/Campbell moved to adjourn. Motion carried 2-0.
