August 5, 2025, 9:00 a.m.

The Floyd County Board of Supervisors met in the Floyd County Courthouse Board Room. Supervisors Boyd Campbell, Gloria Carr, and Joshua Neupert were in attendance.

Carr/Neupert moved to approve the agenda. Motion carried 3-0.

Public comment: Doug Lindaman expressed concerns about the funds spent on wind mediation. He felt that farmers should have had representation during the mediation process and specifically stated that the county should not have paid for Attorney Thomas Reavely's involvement.

Carr/ Neupert moved to approve July 29, 2025 meeting minutes. Motion carried 3-0.

Updates regarding various boards, commissions, and activities since the last meeting:

Carr attended the following meetings County Social Services and Workforce Development Board.

Carr/Neupert moved to approve a \$173,024.10 invoice from Motorola for Communication Tower to be paid for with Tower Project Bonds pending the budget amendment next week. Motion carried 3-0.

Carr/Campbell moved to approve a \$77.99 Ahlers Cooney invoice for Judicial Review of IUC Permit. Motion carried 3-0.

Adam Miller, County Engineer, provided updates on secondary road and office activities. Shoulder work on B60 is ongoing and will continue until Mathy Construction begins resurfacing. Culvert replacements on Packard are on hold until the B60 work is complete. Minor storm damage has been reported, including washouts and fallen branches, with Timber Avenue south of 240th Street closed due to a road and culvert washout. Mowing, blading, and spraying operations are active, with all three mowers in use. In the office, construction projects are progressing. Heartland Asphalt is finishing work on T38 this week (road closed with detour) and began work on B47 last week, which is currently one lane but expected to open next week. T26 is scheduled for late September. Mathy

Construction is tentatively starting B60 resurfacing next week, and Kingland Construction is beginning work on the Rockford Shop. The CHBP Grant application has been submitted by the state.

Todd Schriever, Veterans Affairs Director, provided an update on the Veterans Affairs department activities.

Gail Arjes, Public Health Director, provided an update on the Public Health department activities.

Arjes presented multiple quotes for increased security in the public health building. These quotes include key card access for employees and a push button for clients at the main entrance. Communication Innovators' quote is 5958.18 Central Lock Security is 5300. An additional quote from Century lock includes a camera for the office that cannot see the main entrance for \$7,270. Carr/Neupert moved forward with the Communication Innovators quote for \$5,958.18 and installed a separate camera for the office that is unable to see the main entrance. Motion carried 3-0.

The board noted the General Assistance Annual Report for the year ending June 30, 2025.

Campbell/Carr moved to approve the Fingers & Toes liquor license renewal application. Motion carried 3-0.

The board noted the hiring of Jessica Hartwell as a full-time Auditor's Clerk for \$22.50/hour.

Neupert/Campbell moved to adjourn. Motion carried 3-0.
