Updates regarding various boards, commissions, and activities since the last meeting: Carr attended the following meetings: Communities Partners Protecting Children (CPPC), Decat Governance Board, Floyd-Mitchell Counties Child Abuse Prevention Council, and the Central Iowa Juvenile Detention Center Financial Committee. Rottinghaus attended the Chamber of Commerce Board of Directors meeting and observed the Planning and Zoning meeting. All three attended the Iowa State University Solar and Battery Energy Storage Systems workshop.

Elizabeth Thyer, Gardiner & Company Partner and CPA, presented the FY25 audit report, including financial statements, supplementary information, and the schedule of findings.

Renae Harris, Child Abuse Prevention Council Vice President for Floyd and Mitchell Counties presented two proclamations. Rottinghaus/ Campbell moved to approved Child Abuse Prevention Month Proclamation. Motion carried 3-0. Campbell/Rottinghaus regarding Sexual Assault Awareness Month Proclamation. Motion carried 3-0.

Rottinghaus provided an update on Drainage District #9 repairs, noting Downing Excavating identified an 800–1,000 tile obstruction believed to be located in CRP ground, with repairs delayed due to wet conditions. Mike

Quade presented photos showing open holes and a single tile carrying water and requested a repair timeline. Rottinghaus will communicate with Secondary Roads Superintendent, Tim Laube and the contractor.

The Board noted the receipt North Iowa Area Council of Government FY25 Audit Report

Rottinghaus/Campbell moved to approve the Noxious Weed publication and directed Auditor Montagne to send to publication. Motion carried 3-0.

Rottinghaus/Campbell moved to approve a five-day liquor license effective May 29 for Traveling Tapster LLC., located at 2526 US Highway 218, Charles City, Iowa 50616. Motion carried 3-0.

Future agenda items: Child Support Services County Staffing Contract, review of RFP for Auditing Service and Recognition of Veterans Affairs Director.
